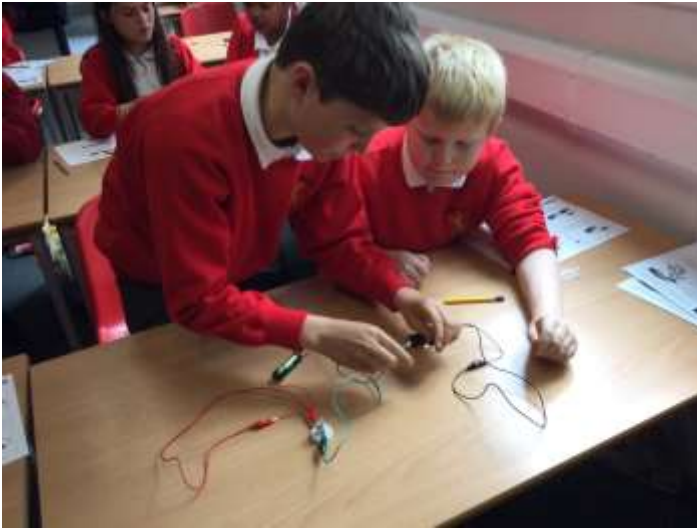

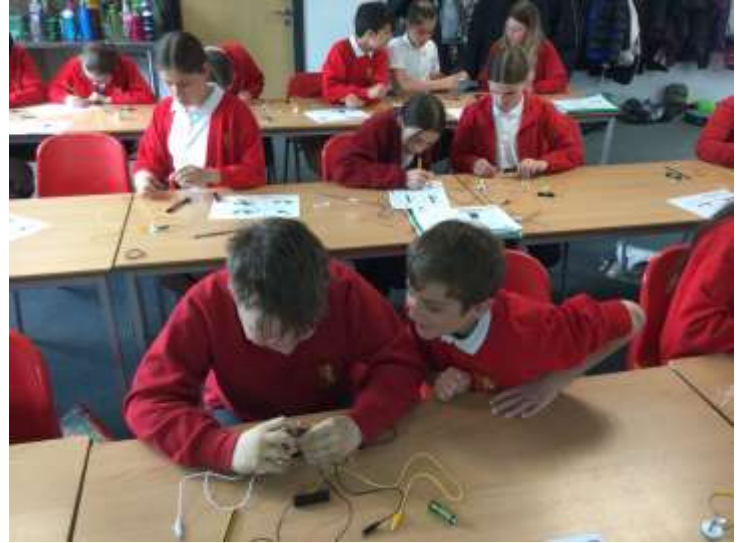
Year 5 have been learning how to draw an Emperor Penguin. This is Emily's beautiful drawing



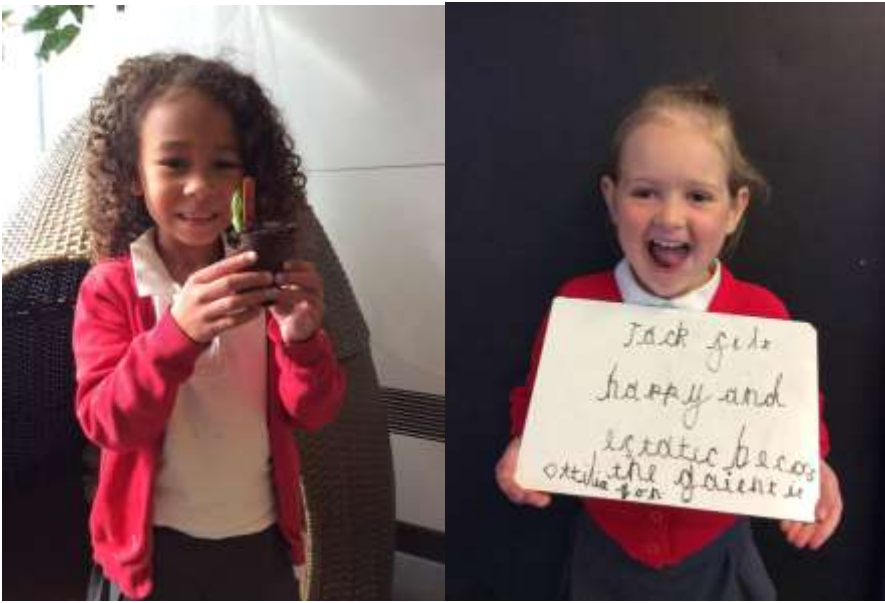
Year 5 have been discussing climate change in PSHE in preparation for starting our Blue Peter Climate Heroes pledges.
