Summary of Spending

Objectives for spending the grant:

1. To ensure that PE is well managed and led - this leads to improvements in PE and school sport.
2. To provide training, development and purchase resources to ensure all staff teach PE well.
3. To employ additional staff (teachers and coaches) to work alongside teachers in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence in PE.
4. To employ a specialist teacher to lead after-school sports clubs to include all children whatever their need.
5. To pay staff and external sports coaches to run competitions and increase participation in national school games competitions.
6. To buy into existing local sports networks such as school sports partnerships.
7. To provide more opportunities for children at after school clubs.
8. To provide support for children and adults who support sport and other activities in school.
9. To ensure that children develop healthy lifestyles.
