You have been amazing this term. Thank you from Mr Murphy, Mrs Levinsohn, Mrs Rooney and Miss Smale.

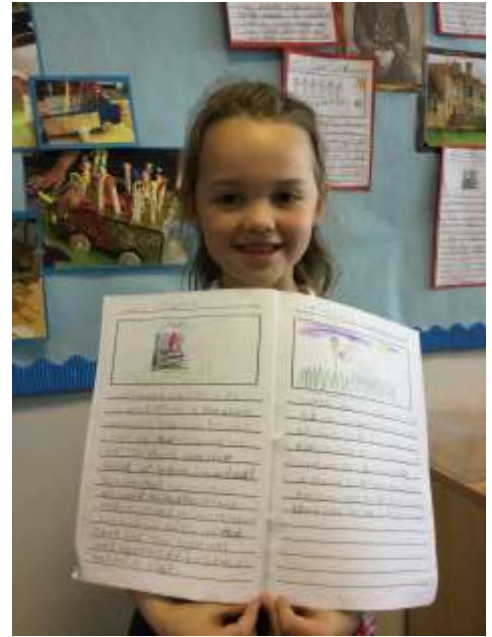


This week in Year 3, children put all their running techniques into action to have some competitions. Year 3 were so supportive of each other, well done Year 3!
