Covid-19 Alert

There continues to be a concerning rise in cases in Cheshire East. I attended a meeting yesterday, which reported the Delta variant is now present in every Local Authority in the country. We need to continue to behave appropriately and our systems and procedures in school will continue. We will continue to take every opportunity to have learning outdoors too. Please read the advice below carefully regarding Covid symptoms.

Please inform school if you or any member of your household presents with symptoms and follow the advice below.

Pupils, staff and other adults must not come into the school if:

- they have one or more COVID-19 symptoms
- a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has COVID-19 symptoms
- they are legally required to quarantine, having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area
- they have had a positive test or have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19

If then a member of a household with symptoms tests positive then all members of the family must self-isolate for 10 days. If the test is negative then children can return to school.

Self-isolation of 10 days from the day after:

- the start of their symptoms
- the test date if they did not have any symptoms but have had a positive LFD or PCR test (if an LFD test is taken first, and a PCR test is then taken within 2 days of the positive lateral flow test, and is negative, it overrides the LFD test and the pupil can return to school)

Sun Safety

This lovely sunny weather is wonderful and has certainly raised our spirits but children need to be kept safe in the sunshine so please:

- Apply sun cream at home before leaving for school – staff are not permitted to apply sun cream
- Children to wear a hat and have their water bottle with them

Please ensure hats and all items of uniform are clearly labelled with a child's name. We have an alarming amount of uniform without names.
