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Covid-19

This week I met with the Knutsford Headteachers. This includes Little Bollington, Mobberley and High Legh. I am sure you are aware that the three town schools have classes self-isolating and the village schools have all experienced cases. We have received advice that we need to be extremely cautious as numbers of positive cases are rising rapidly.

Many who have tested positive have not had the usual covid-19 symptoms and have experienced a mild headache and/or cold. Our advice would be to book a PCR test if you are at all concerned. Please inform the school immediately if this is the case.

Please inform school if you or any member of your household presents with symptoms and follow the advice below.

Pupils, staff and other adults must not come into the school if:

- they have one or more COVID-19 symptoms
- a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has COVID-19 symptoms
- they are legally required to quarantine, having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area
- they have had a positive test have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19

If then a member of a household with symptoms tests positive then all members of the family must self-isolate for 10 days. If the test is negative then children can return to school.

Self-isolation of 10 days from the day after:

- the start of their symptoms
- the test date if they did not have any symptoms but have had a positive LFD or PCR test (if an LFD test is taken first, and a PCR test is then taken within 2 days of the positive lateral flow test, and is negative, it overrides the LFD test and the pupil can return to school)

Sun Safety

This lovely sunny weather is wonderful and has certainly raised our spirits but children need to be kept safe in the sunshine so please:

- Apply sun cream at home before leaving for school – staff are not permitted to apply sun cream
- Children to wear a hat and have their water bottle with them

Please ensure hats and all items of uniform are clearly labelled with a child's name. We have an alarming amount of uniform without names.

This week, Year 6 had a wonderful afternoon rehearsing their play on Wednesday in front of one of our ex pupils. Lenny Turner trained at The Royal Academy of Music and has an MA in Musical Theatre so was on hand to offer advice on singing, acting and stage presence! Afterwards he said all the children were an absolute joy to work with.

Reception have been thinking about Father's Day and important people in our lives. The children may be coming home with something special but make sure you do not open before Sunday!




Year 5 showed their amazing drama skills this week in RE, when they were producing and performing plays about forgiveness.
