Covid Advice

Attached with this newsletter is an advice leaflet for parents regarding covid. If you are at all unsure about anything, please don't hesitate to get in touch. Mrs McAll and I will be able to answer most questions and if we can't we will certainly find out for you.

Updated Guidance has been received from Cheshire East so please follow this going forward: If a member of your family has symptoms, please do not send your child into school until the person with symptoms receives a negative PCR test.

Do household contacts who get PCR test have to isolate whilst waiting for test result?

Government advice is that contacts can continue to work / attend school whilst waiting for a PCR result. However, following a discussion with schools, Cheshire East Public Health recommendation is that **household** contacts are advised to remain at home until they receive a negative PCR result. This is because household contacts are more at risk of contracting the virus.

Drop off and Pick up Times

- The school gate will be opened at 8.40am. A member of the Senior Leadership Team will be on the playground from 8.45am.
- Children in Years 3,4,5 and 6 can go straight into school at 8.45am.
- At 8.55am a whistle will be blown in the Infant playground. Reception children enter via their classroom. Year 1 children line up and Year 2 children make their way around the building to their cloakroom.
- The school day ends at 3.20pm. The school gate will be opened at 3.10pm for parents to enter to pick up their children. All children should be collected by an adult unless the school have been informed otherwise eg. Some Year 6 children walk home

A Peek in the Classrooms

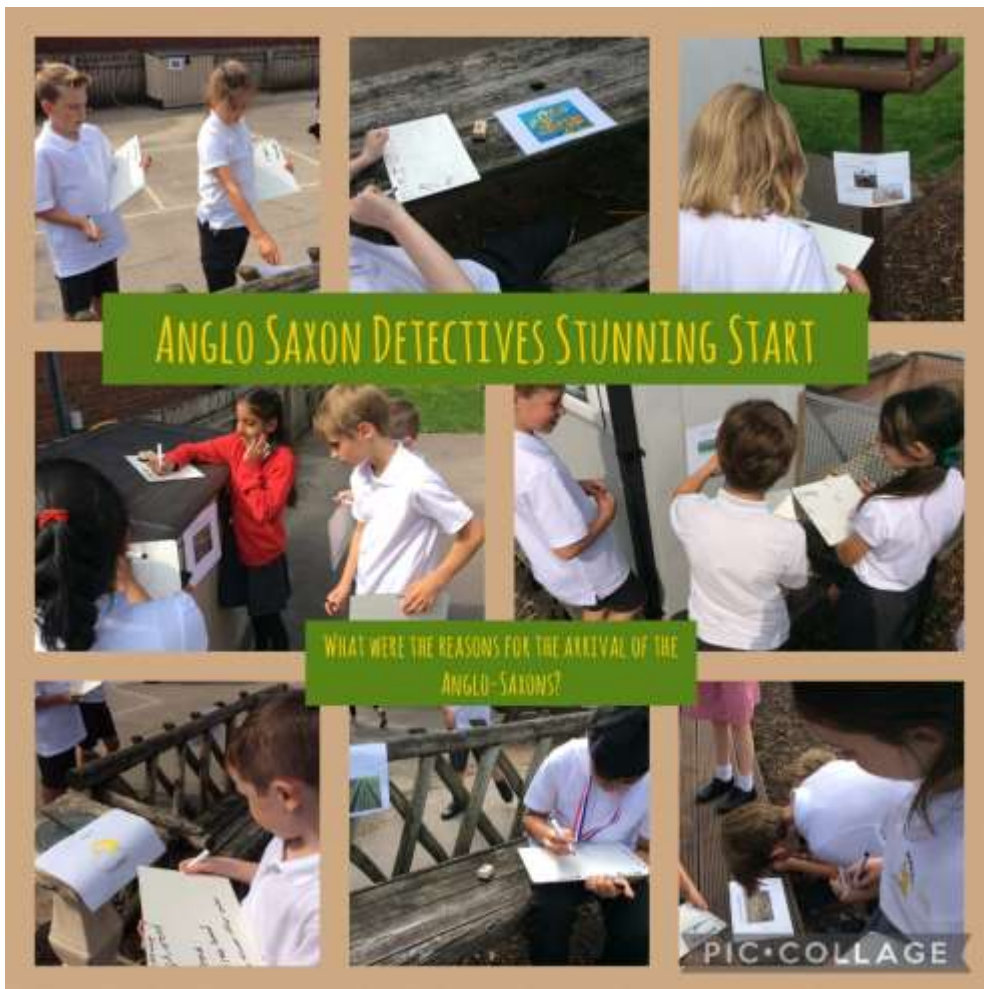


This week in Year 3, children participated in an archaeological dig for our Tribal Tales Stunning Start. Children uncovered some very special artefacts!
