PHE and the LA have issued further guidance to schools regarding positive household cases and periods of isolation.

1. Pupils who are household contacts advised to stay at home for 5 days, limit social contact and get a PCR test before coming back. Eligible pupils to do daily LFTs on their return for remainder of the 10 day period.


If you have a positive case in your household, please contact school as soon as possible and school staff will advise you of isolation requirements.


Staggered start/finish and the cancellation of all after school clubs such as multiflex, netball and choir will continue until half term.






Year 1 have been reading the story of The Three Little Pigs! They explored which materials worked best for building a house!
